**COVID-19 Daily Situation Report

Summary of 07/07/2020

- Compared to the previous day, the number of new COVID-19 cases decreased (-7,4%).
- Considering the percentage changes of cases by NUTS-1 the highest decrease was in the Western Marmara and Western Anatolia Regions (-58,3% and -35,8%). The highest increase was in Northeastern Anatolia Region (80,0%). When analyzed in terms of the number of cases, this difference was only 8 cases.
- The number of new COVID-19 cases per 1.000.000 population was 12 for women and 18 for men among the 80 aged and over.




Figure 1: Number of New COVID-19 Cases by NUTS-1, Turkey




Figure 2: New COVID-19 Cases per 1.000.000 Population by Age Group and Sex, Turkey

$$\text{Percent change} = \frac{(\text{New value} - \text{Old value})}{\text{Old value}} * 100$$
