COVID-19 Daily Situation Report 02/08/2020 Turkey



03/08/2020

Summary of 02/08/2020

- Compared to the previous day, the number of new COVID-19 patients decreased (-1,1%).
- Considering the percentage of changes in the patients by NUTS-1, the highest decrease
 was in the Eastern Blacksea Region (-41,2%), the highest increase was in the Eastern
 Marmara compared to the previous day. When analyzed in terms of the number of
 patients, this difference was only 10 patients.
- The number of new COVID-19 patients per 1.000.000 population was 15,3 for women and 17,7 for men among the 65-79 age group.
- Western Blacksea Region has the highest decrease in the number of new hospitalizations (-37,5%). On the other hand, the Western Marmara Region has the highest increase in the number of new hospital discharges compared to the previous day (20,0%).



Notes:

- All COVID-19 patients are laboratory confirmed.
- Data in the Daily Situation Report includes the period between 00:00 and 23:59.
- As of the first COVID-19 patients in Turkey were notified on 11 March 2020, patients more than once hospitalized, intubated and discharged from hospital are included only once in the calculation of indicators.
- Percentage change is an indicator that represents the degree of change over the previous day.
 The calculation is as follows:

 $Percent \ change = \frac{(New \ value - Old \ value)}{Old \ value} * 100$
